

When You Visit the Museum...



Kaleideum Adjustments:

- Social distancing floor stickers have been placed at the Welcome Desk.
- Plexiglass shields have been placed at the Welcome Desk and Gift Shop register.
- Hand sanitizing stations have been placed throughout the museum.
- Additional floor staff will be cleaning and sanitizing exhibits throughout the day.
- Small exhibit pieces are rotated and cleaned frequently.
- Suggested path for entry is to start your visit in Physics Works.



Visitor Adjustments:

- Adults and children over 12, please wear a face mask when you are in the building.
- Do not come to the museum if you don't feel well, have any symptoms of respiratory illness, or have a temperature.
- Purchase tickets online ahead of time to minimize transactions at the Welcome Desk.
- Please stand 6 feet apart when waiting in line at the Welcome Desk or Gift Shop.
- Avoid crowding around an exhibit area.
- Practice respiratory etiquette.
- Utilize hand sanitizer stations throughout the museum.
- Please be patient as we are navigating this new normal.



Steps That Our Employees Are Taking:


Before Leaving the House:

- Employees will ensure they are not/have not been showing any COVID-19 symptoms over the last 72 hours. If they have, they will call their supervisor and stay home.
- Employees will make sure they have a clean face mask that was washed and dried on hot settings.




When They Arrive at Work:

- Employees will wear a mask as they enter. They will enter through only one designated entrance.
- Employees will enter the "Screening Room," take their temperature and answer three questions on the sign-in sheet.



While They Are in Kaleideum:

- Employees will wipe down all common touch points after use.
- Employees will wear a mask and social distance!



Some Helpful Reminders!

Know Your Ws!

WEAR:

a cloth face mask if you're over 12 years old.

WAIT:

6 feet apart, avoid close contact.

WASH:

your hands often or use hand sanitizer.
