

Girl Scout Camp-In

Hello & Welcome!

We're so excited to have your Troop join us for the Girl Scout Camp-in at our new Kaleideum location at 120 W Third St in Downtown Winston-Salem. Below are details you will need to know before arriving. Please notify Lindsay Douglas immediately if your attendance numbers have changed.

We want to make the evening fun and safe for all participants, so please let us know if we can do anything to accommodate scouts or parents with special needs, allergies, phobias, etc. If you have questions, please email Lindsay Douglas at ldouglas@kaleideum.org.

What to bring:

Each person will need at least a sleeping bag and pillow, and whatever else you feel is necessary to be comfortable. We have concrete flooring with carpet tiles on top in most exhibit areas, so we recommend bringing sleeping mats or pads if you think you need that to be comfortable. Some campers change into sleeping attire, while others wear something comfortable in which they can remain all night. We do have emergency lights that will remain on all night so the museum will not get completely dark, if that feels uncomfortable to anyone, we recommend bringing a sleeping mask. Although some lights will remain on, flashlights may still come in handy. We will be serving dinner during the evening. If you do bring snack items, they may only be eaten in our cafeteria area. Vending machines are available for snack items and soft drinks if desired until one hour before "Lights Out". Some people do get hot or cold, we suggest dressing in layers. Kaleideum does not provide showers, cots, or air mattresses.

Suggested items to bring:

Prescription medicines if needed	Flashlight
Hand towel/ Washcloth/ Toiletries	Pillow/ Blanket/ Sleeping attire
Sleeping bag pad, cot, or air mattress and pump	Batteries for camera or pump

Check-in:

Check-in will begin at **5:30pm**. Orientation will begin at **6:45pm**. Please try and arrive by 6:30pm. One adult should be designated to check-in for your group. They will receive maps of the museum and information about workshop times, classroom assignments, dinner schedule, and sleeping area to share with the group. **If your group plans to arrive at staggered times, please plan to have one adult remain near the check-in area to direct arriving campers to their designated area. Leaders should plan to arrive first if possible.** Activities will begin at **6:45pm sharp** ...please enjoy museum exhibits until that time.

Friday Evening:

The camp-in will consist of dinner, a badge program, museum exhibit free time, and a chance to view a planetarium show. An itinerary indicating your time for participating in each activity will be provided at check-in. After 5:00pm our main phone number will be rolled into voicemail. If there is an emergency and someone from your Troop must be reached, **please call our night number at (336)528-9995.**

Dinner will consist of:

- Cheese pizza or pepperoni pizza (2 slices/person)
- Pretzels
- Apple slices
- Carrots with ranch dressing
- Lemonade/water

Saturday Morning:

Coffee will be available in our cafeteria area beginning at 7:00am for those ADULTS needing to jump-start their morning. A continental breakfast will be provided for all participants; check your itinerary at check-in for exact times. The camp-in will end at 9:00am. **Don't forget to stop by the registration desk on your way out to pick up your Kaleideum patches.**

Kaleideum North Girl Scout Camp-In General Schedule format:

Friday Evening:

5:30-6:30	Check-in - One adult should be designated to check-in for your group. They will receive museum maps, a schedule, and sleeping area assignment. Please enjoy museum exhibits until orientation
6:45-7:00	Orientation - All scouts, leaders, and chaperones should attend orientation.
7:00-8:15	Dinner/ Museum Time – Check your individual schedule for specific times and locations.
8:15-10:15	Badge work/activities/ planetarium - Check your individual schedule for specific times.
10:15-11:00	Sleep Prep. Lights out! - Lights can begin to go off as soon as Troops are ready

Saturday Morning:

7:00-8:00	Coffee and Continental breakfast - in cafeteria area
8:00-9:00	Pack up/ Museum Time - PLEASE NOTE: Scouts need to have all gear packed and removed from museum by 9:00am. Leaders should stop by the front desk for camp-in participation patches, if they have not already received them from staff.
9:00	Camp-in will end. Please have all gear out of the museum by this time.
